During colonial period, it was the center of government, education and culture in the colony of Virginia.</i></p>	<p><b>Dinner—Sal's Italian</b></p> <p>Group travels to Washington, DC</p> <p>Hotel check-in. Professional security guard monitors each floor.</p>

Vernon</b> <i>George Washington's home, which includes a tour of the Mansion house and more than a dozen outbuildings</i></p> <p><b>Old Town Alexandria</b> <i>Historic district known for preserved homes, galleries and restaurants</i></p>	<p><b>Lunch—Museum Cafeteria</b></p> <p><b>SMITHSONIAN COMPLEX</b> <b>Natural History Museum</b> <i>Located on the National Mall, the museum's collections total over 125 million specimens of plants, animals, fossils, minerals, rocks and human cultural artifacts</i></p> <p><b>National Gallery of Art</b> <i>Includes many paintings by masters like Rembrandt, Monet, Van Gogh, Leonardo da Vinci, Picasso, Matisse, Warhol and more</i></p> <p><b>National Air &amp; Space Museum</b> <i>Features the largest collection of aircraft and spacecraft in the world, like the original Wright Flyer.</i></p>	<p><b>Dinner—Reagan Trade Center</b></p> <p><b>NIGHT TOUR</b> <b>Iwo Jima Memorial</b> <i>Dedicated to all US Marines who have died in the defense of their country. Based on the iconic photo from the Battle of Iwo Jima</i></p> <p><b>Jefferson Memorial</b> <i>Round-shaped memorial honoring the country's third president Thomas Jefferson</i></p> <p><b>Lincoln Memorial</b> <i>Honoring 16<sup>th</sup> president and location of MLK's famous "I have a dream" speech</i></p> <p><b>Kennedy Center</b> <i>Performing arts centre, located beside the Potomac River, adjacent to the famous Watergate Hotel</i></p> <p>Return to hotel. Professional security guard monitors each floor.</p>

<b>DAY 4</b>	<p><b>Breakfast–Hotel buffet</b></p> <p>Group boards sightseeing bus  <b>White House</b> (photo stop)  <i>Group photo taken in front of the home of the President</i></p> <p><b>Washington Monument</b> <i>A 555-foot tall white obelisk located at the west end of the National Mall that was built to honor the first president, George Washington.</i></p> <p><b>National Archives</b> <i>Preserves and documents government historical records such as the Declaration of Independence &amp; the US Constitution</i></p>	<p><b>Lunch–Union Station</b></p> <p><b>CAPITOL HILL</b>  <b>US Capitol</b> <i>Serves as the seat of government for the US Congress, the legislative branch of the US federal government</i></p> <p><b>Supreme Court</b> <i>Highest judicial body in the US</i></p> <p><b>Library of Congress</b> <i>One of the most important libraries in the world, it includes the largest rare book collection in North America, including a Gutenberg Bible</i></p>	<p><b>Dinner–Old Country Buffet</b></p> <p><b>World War II Memorial</b> <i>National war memorial that honors members of the US armed forces who died in service or were unaccounted for during these wars</i></p> <p>Return to hotel. Professional security guard monitors each floor.</p>
