Improvisation Workshop

The Improvisation Workshop is an interactive foray into the world of acting and improvising. It's an opportunity to learn how improvising works and to jump right in and give it a whirl! Unleashing spontaneity and creativity is the goal, while veteran improvisers and teachers provide a supportive atmosphere for all participants.

Auditioning for the Theatre

Conducted by a NY Casting Director, this workshop focuses on the audition process for Broadway and Off-Broadway productions. Each student will have an opportunity to do a cold reading of some actual audition scripts and work with a casting director to simulate an authentic audition and interview.

New York: Inside and Out

Conducted by professional actors, this workshop prepares students for the real-life skills needed to be a working actor. Many practical tips are offered. For example, what skills should you keep sharpened now to make you more marketable when you move to NY? What kind of side jobs is best for an auditioning actor? Where is the best place to live for an auditioning actor? How many auditions should you go on in a week?

Live Comedy Show at the Laugh Factory

The troupe, Eight is Never Enough, delivers two hours of hilarious comedy in the format of Whose Line Is It, Anyway? This workshop is designed to entertain and encourage laughter. Students will have the opportunity to be an integral part of the creative process by offering suggestions to the actors for each story and song. Audience members are invited on stage throughout this performance. They follow up with a question and answer about the nature of improvisational comedy.

A Mock Broadway Audition

A NY performer/choreographer teaches the steps to a combination used for auditions for a popular Broadway musical such as Mamma Mia. This workshop simulates an authentic Broadway musical audition.

Acting for the Camera

A Casting director/instructor will guide students through the real differences between stage acting and acting before a camera. Students will be lead through several readings to simulate an authentic commercial audition.

Alvin Ailey Dance Workshop

The prestigious Alvin Ailey School customizes special classes for your group tied to their age and level of proficiency in dance. All classes are taught by distinguished dance faculty and are accompanied by live music performed by professional musicians. This workshop is a must for any group enthusiastic about dance.

Post Performance Discussions

After seeing a spectacular show, imagine meeting with cast and crew members to ask questions about how they make the show sensational. Theatre houses offer after show meetings, if requests are made in advance. While not all theatres participate, STA will work with you to customize the tour meeting your group's needs.
